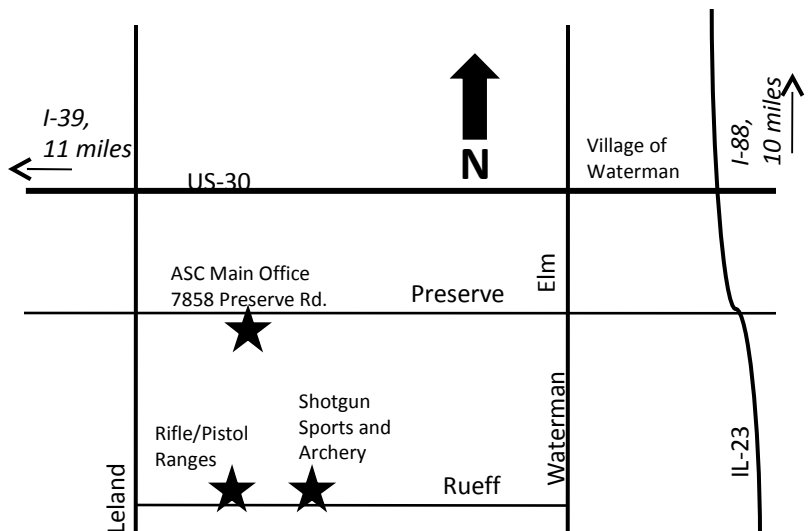

A valid Illinois Firearm Owners Identification Card (FOID) is required for all Illinois resident firearm shooters of any age except when the individual is a minor and accompanied by a parent or guardian in possession of a valid Illinois FOID Card.

Check-in is at the Aurora Sportsmen's Club Main Office at 7858 Preserve Road . To get to the office from the traffic light at route 30 and Elm St in Waterman, drive south on Elm approximately 1/2 mile to Preserve road. Turn right on Preserve Road, the office is approximately 1 mile west on the south side of the road. (Elm becomes Waterman Road)
